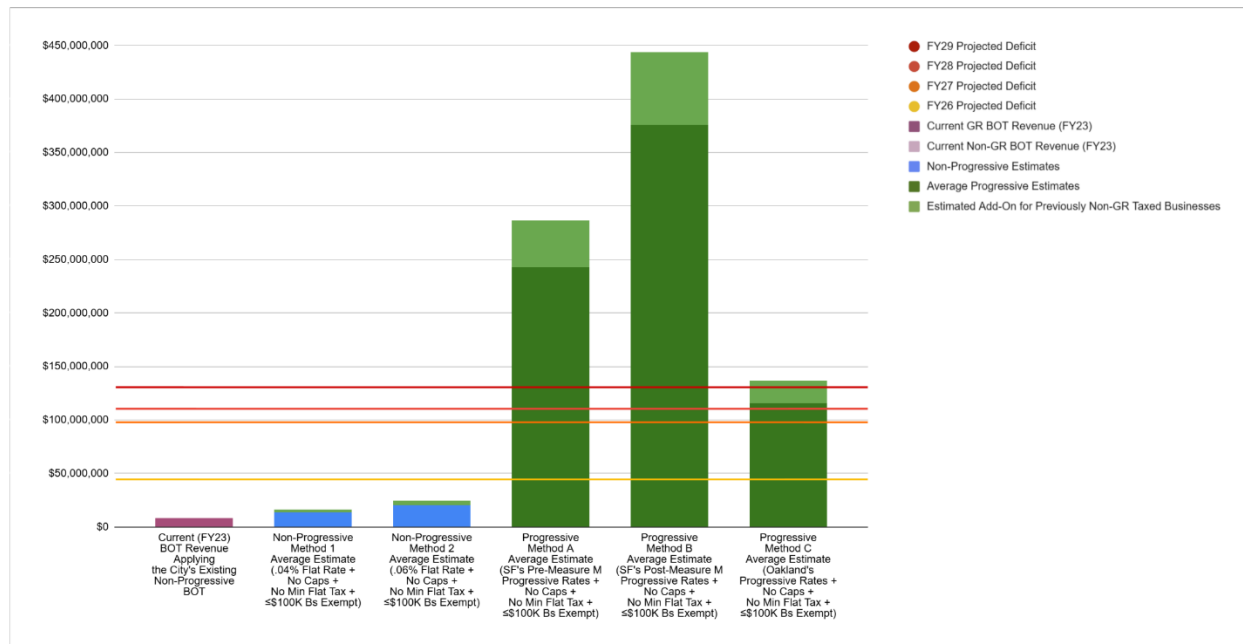

Re: Proposal Designed to Eliminate Our Budget Deficits While Increasing Economic Growth and Fairness

Dear Mayor McCarty, Councilmember Talamantes, other members of the City Council,

I have written before about various concerns, but this time I am writing with good news! **According to my research, this council could *more than eliminate* the city's growing budget deficits and ongoing unfairness in our business operations tax (BOT) system—while also stimulating economic growth by jump-starting new and small businesses—**simply by following the lead of some of the city's self-identified peer jurisdictions and putting a *progressive* BOT measure on the ballot in 2026, as the following chart illustrates:
